

## Sister's love at Claverdon



Sisters Holly and Ellee received the keys to their brand new homes in Breach Lane, Claverdon when the scheme of three 2 bed affordable homes finally completed in May. The development comprises of two 2 bedroom houses for shared ownership purchase and one 2 bedroom house for Social Rent.

Holly has lived in Claverdon since the age of two when her parents moved here, Ellee was born in the village and has lived here ever since. Both sisters were pupils at the neighbouring primary school and now work at the local nursery school which is run by their Mother.

These new homes have proven to be hugely popular and were locally oversubscribed when they were allocated last year.Combined with evidence of further local housing needs, plans are to be submitted later this summer to develop a further 12 local needs affordable homes on the adjacent land in Breach lane.
